Keep Jackson Beautiful invite students to celebrate Earth Day 2024 by competing in a Poster Contest!

Who? 6th Grade Students

What? We are looking for posters that emphasize Earth Day! This is a day to celebrate our environment: air, water, land, wildlife, and ecosystems! The posters must represent one or more Earth Day themes. Posters will be judged on their artistic merits and on how well they conveyed the message. Example: having healthy, sustainably-produced school food is good for students and good for the planet.

Where? The Winners of the Earth Day Poster Contest will be honored on Tuesday, April 30, 2024, at their respective schools!

When? All original entries must be received by April 19, 2024. Winners will be notified by April 24, 2024.

The 1st place winner will receive \$100
The 2nd place winner will receive \$50
The 3rd place winner will receive \$25
All participants will receive certificates.

Here are the rules you must follow:

1. The artwork must be about the environment. The posters must represent one or more Earth Day themes: air, water, land, solar, gardening, wildlife, and ecosystems.
2. Poster size is typically 11" x 17" paper; it must fit into a 16" x 20" frame.
3. Posters can be full color or black and white, and made with crayon, colored pencil, watercolor, pen, marker, or paint.
4. Entries may be turned in on or before **3:00 pm Friday, April 19, 2024.**
5. For 6 grade students only.
